



The National Dance Company of Spain's 2024 U.S. Tour in New Orleans



Compañía Nacional de Danza, Spain's premier national dance company, returns to New Orleans after 22 years to present a trio of performances covering classical, neoclassical, and contemporary dance: "Sad Case," "White Darkness" and "Passengers Within."

Led by Artistic Director [Joaquín De Luz](#), a world-renowned past principal dancer with New York City Ballet, Compañía Nacional de Danza will perform a North American premiere of mixed repertoire embracing classical to avant-garde:

- [White Darkness](#) by CNdD's former artistic director and choreographer Nacho Duato, a one-act ballet created as a requiem;
- The satirical [Sad Case](#) by Sol León and Paul Lightfoot, which embodies the fiery, syncopated rhythms of Mexican mambo;
- And [Passengers Within](#), the latest creation by De Luz, set to music by Philip Glass.
