He has published several books in Spain, including the novels *Paris* (Herralde Novel Award), *Los seres felices* and *Tiempo de vida* (Spanish National Book Award), the novella *Nada sucede solo* and the collections of short stories *Entiéndame* and *El final del amor* (International Short Fiction Award Ribera del Duero).

## NICOLÁS CASARIEGO

Nicolás Casariego was born in Madrid in 1970. His latest title is Carahueca, a movie tie-in book of the screenplay he co-wrote for Clive Owen's project, *Intruders*. In 2008 he was awarded the Writers Omi residence fellowship for international writers at Ledig House, New York. *Antón Mallick Wants to Be Hapy* is his first novel in Englishlanguage translation.
