Currently the Music Director/Conductor of PostClassical Ensemble and Principal Guest Conductor of New York's Perspectives Ensemble, Gil-Ordóñez is also Music Director of the Georgetown University Orchestra in Washington, D.C. Additionally, he serves as advisor for education and programming for Trinitate Philharmonia, a program in León, Mexico, modeled on Venezuela's El Sistema. Opera Colorado, the Pacific Symphony, the Hartford Symphony, the Brooklyn Philharmonic, the Orchestra of St. Luke's. Abroad, he has conducted the Munich Philharmonic, the Solistes de Berne, at the Schleswig-Holstein Music Festival, and at the Bellas Artes National Theatre in Mexico City.

Gil-Ordóñez is the former Associate Conductor of the National Orchestra of Spain. He has recorded four albums devoted to Spanish composers. Of the seven PostClassical Ensemble (PCE) CDs and DVDs he has recorded with PostClassical Ensemble for Naxos, *The City* and *Redes* were world premiere recordings of the soundtracks by Aaron Copland and Silvestre Revueltas, respectively. His most recent Naxos CD with PCE, featuring music by Lou Harrison, has been acclaimed on four continents.
