



Txemi Parra: La familia bien, gracias



Txemi Parra retraces his life and the role of his family in the stand-up comedy “La familia bien, gracias.”

Well-known Spanish actor Txemi Parra presents a stand-up show retracing his life from childhood to adulthood, highlighting the turning points and the role his family played.

When he arrived in New York, he created with Lorenzo Parro *Bilbainadas*, a TV series that went viral, about the difficulties that two people from the Basque Country encounter while walking around New York.

Txemi Parra was one of the first monologists on [Comedy Central](#) where he performed five monologues. He was shortlisted for the second contest of the *Comedy Club*, a popular Spanish comedy show. He is also an actor, presenter, writer and stand-up comedian. As an actor he has participated in many TV series like *Tierra de lobos* (*Land of Wolves*), *7 vidas* (*7 Lives*) and *Mis adorables vecinos* (*My adorable neighbors*), and was also a screenwriter for sitcoms like *Aida* or *Los Serrano*.
