The TV shows include *El Comisario*, *Petra Delicado*, *7 vidas*, *Paraiso*, *La Lola*. He played in *Cachorros de negro mirar* by P. Pedrero, a theater play which toured Spain.

As a Globomedia screenwriter, he wrote such shows as 7 *Vidas*, *Aída*, *Los Serrano*, *El Internado* or *Águila Roja*. As an author, he won the Ciudad de Donosti award for *La Manzana*. And he has presented three plays at CCEMiami (Centro Cultural Espanol de Cooperación Iberoamericana.)

He writes and acts for the *Bilbainadas WebSerie*. and was one of the first Paramount Channel comedians and finalist of *El Club de la comedia*. His first novel, *Los muertos no comen yogures* was published in Spain in 2016.
