



Hinds 2016 U.S. Tour in San Francisco



The all-female Madrid-based band Hinds is back in the U.S. to present their album *Leave Me Alone*.

Hinds (Ana Perrote, Carlotta Cosials, Ade Martin and Amber Grimbergen) have mastered a raw and playful sound all their own, and their no-holds-barred DIY attitude has only seen them go from strength to strength.

In just 18 months the Madrid quartet have gone from a first London sold-out show at The Sebright Arms (their fifth-ever gig) to a sold out KOKO as part of their current World Tour. The band played a total of 133 shows in 2015, including becoming the first Spanish band to play a main stage at Glastonbury and the ambitious endeavor of 16 gigs in 4 days at SXSW.

With a host of sold-out headline shows across Europe, the USA, Australia and more under their belt, 2016 will see Hinds play even more gigs to even bigger audiences as they continue to establish themselves as one of the most exciting emerging acts in the world.
