

Ignacio Prego in concert at the NGA



In celebration of the exhibition "Sargent and Spain," currently on show at the National Gallery of Art, travel to Andalusia with a performance by the internationally renowned Spanish harpsichordist Ignacio Prego.

2022 marks the centennial of the Concurso de Cante Jondo (Cante Jondo Contest), a cultural event that showcases the art and culture of the Flamenco world in Andalusia. In honor of the anniversary, Ignacio Prego's program of Spanish music includes sonatas by the two most important keyboard composers of the Iberian Baroque: Domenico Scarlatti and Antonio Soler.

ABOUT IGNACIO PREGO

First Prize winner at the 2012 Westfield International Harpsichord Competition, Ignacio Prego has been described by the newspaper *El Mundo* as "...one of the most versatile Spanish musicians in the Classical scene..." He has performed in major cities in the USA, China, Japan, Italy, Spain, Costa Rica, Chile, Holland, Portugal, Italy, Romania, Peru, Bolivia and Canada, including important venues such as the National Gallery of Arts in Washington, D.C., the National Center for the Performing Arts in Beijing, the National Auditorium in Madrid, the Esplanade in Singapore and the Alice Tully Hall at Lincoln Center in New York.

Recent highlights include:

- His debut with The English Concert and Harry Bicket playing Bach's F minor Harpsichord Concerto in New York.
- A solo recital at St. Martin in the Fields in London and in Berkeley, CA, playing Goldberg Variations.
