

Founded in 1982 and guided by the vision and tenacity of four generations of the Encinias family, the National Institute of Flamenco has grown into an expansive array of flamenco programs, including the annual Festival Flamenco Alburquerque, the Conservatory of Flamenco Arts, and diverse performance companies including Yjastros: The American Flamenco Repertory Company, and Tablao Flamenco Albuquerque.

Using flamenco as a vehicle, the Institute activates community and fosters unlimited possibilities through educational engagement, economic development, artistic innovation and excellence, and the intentional pursuit of equity through flamenco.



Celebrating 37 years of Festival Flamenco Alburquerque

In 1987, Professor Eva Encinias was tasked by the University of New Mexico Department of Theatre and Dance to organize a special flamenco performance for the College of Fine Arts' 50th anniversary. Considering the value for her dance students of seeing a variety of professional flamenco artists, Encinias began the hard work of organizing, curating, and promoting this event. The Festival was so successful that the UNM Department of Theatre and Dance asked Encinias if she could make it an annual event. This led to the establishment of Festival Flamenco Alburquerque, now in its 37th year.

Produced annually by the National Institute of Flamenco in collaboration with the University of New Mexico and the National Hispanic Cultural Center, the festival is the largest outside of Spain. It features workshops for students of all ages and levels and performances by acclaimed artists at various venues, attracting attendees from New Mexico and around the world. As the most significant flamenco event outside of Spain, the Festival brings together students, fans, aficionados and some of the world's most acclaimed flamenco artists for nine magical days in June.






























